

Rules of conduct in the event of suspected infection of an employee, student or doctoral student

1. In the event of symptoms suggesting coronavirus infection, stay at home and contact the sanitary-epidemiological station or the infectious disease ward by phone and inform the immediate superior or the relevant dean's office in regards to students.
2. A person showing symptoms of infection should be immediately sent back to their place of residence by means of individual transport. The person is obliged to seek medical advice or report to a sanitary-epidemiological station. If a person showing symptoms of infection cannot travel by means of individual transport, he/she is isolated in a designated room and call for a medical transport.
3. If there is a serious risk of infection, people who had direct contact with a person suspected of being infected with the coronavirus are referred to work remotely or to attend classes remotely.
4. In the event of an infection, you should immediately report this fact to the manager of the facility or student dormitory in order to determine the area in which the suspected person moved and stayed, in order to isolate these rooms. Cleaning and disinfection of the determined area is carried out.
5. Make a list of people staying in the part of the building where the person showing symptoms of infection was present and follow the guidelines of the Chief Sanitary Inspector available at gov.pl/web/koronawirus and gis.gov.pl, referring to people who had contact with an infected person.
